TYPES OF APPLICATION TIMELINES

- Early Decision
 - Binding -- if admitted, must attend
- Early Action
 - Non-Binding -- receive early response, but have until May 1st to decide
- Priority Deadline
 - Usually associated with merit-based scholarships
- Rolling Admission
- Regular Admission

STEP 2: APPLYING COLLEGE(S)

TYPICAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Where to apply?
 - University's Individual Application
 - The Coalition Application
 - Common App
 - Common Black College Application
- Application Fee
 - Fee Waiver (ask your High School Counselor)
- SAT/ACT Scores
 - Superscore?
 - Test Optional
 - Admission? Scholarships?

STEP 2: APPLYING **COLLEGE(S)**

ADDITIONAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Letters of Recommendation
 - Ask people who can speak to your academic track record/potential
 - Give at least 3+ weeks notice
- Admission Essay
- Resume
- Major Specific Requirements
 - Additional Application
 - Audition
 - Portfolio

 - Set admissions requirements
- Holistic Review
 - Every student is reviewed on a case by case basis
